



VWA AFL Victoria Country Permit Application Table

The following table is designed to assist clubs in entering the correct permit to suit the player situation.

Type 1. Match Day – (no home club permission required in Footyweb)
Player shortage between competing clubs on match day
Junior club member of the same affiliated club into under 18 or senior grade team.
League permitting a player into a representative team. (1 off match)
Player being permitted into an AFL Victoria representative side. (1 off match)
Player being permitted into a V/Line Cup representative side. (1 off match)
Type 2. Local Interchange –(home club permission required in Footyweb)
Match permit – junior or district league player into major league.
Signed interchange agreement between leagues where player approval has been provided by the home club.
To play AFL/TAC cup season
Special request permit (split families)
To Superules league's if still playing community football
Students living away from Home 2.11
League permitting a player into a representative team. (if fixture more than 1 day)
Player being permitted into an AFL Victoria representative side. (if fixture more than 1 day)
Player being permitted into a V/Line Cup representative side. (if fixture more than 1 day)
Junior club member of the same affiliated club into under 18 or senior grade team if the player is under 16 years of age.
Type 3. Temporary transfer (home club permission required in Footyweb)
Temporary permit for players of club in recess (12 month period)
Players transferring between NT and Vic
